

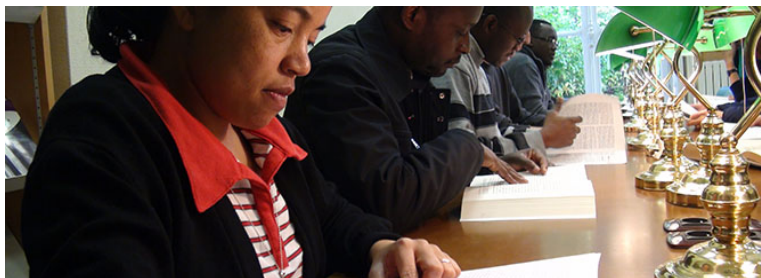
Faculty of Canon Law
