## Course description

The course centers on the reading and analysis of authentic English language documents destined for a highly educated adult audience (*The Atlantic, The Economist*). The students make a presentation about a news topic of their choice in English and write an in-class essay. Topics include China-Taiwan tensions, the conflicts in the Middle East, and the genocide in Tigray.

# **Learning Objectives**

- > The students are taught to read high-level English language articles, put them in context and improve their knowledge of general culture.
- > To encourage students to engage in thoughtful discourse and debate on media-related issues.

## Methods of Instruction

Interactive lectures by the professor, discussions, debates, student presentations (with instructions provided by the teacher, questions, and feedback).

## Assessment and Final grade

One presentation in English and one written exam focusing on a geopolitical topic.
