Course description

This class teaches the basics of film analysis. The first semester will introduce students to the terminology and theoretical frameworks of film analysis, and notably learn about such key filmmaking elements as composition, *mise-en-scène*, the use of light, narration, and character identification. The second semester will focus on longer segments of film. The students will study clips in class taken from a limited number of films that the students should watch at home in their. Each class will be dedicated to film of a specific genre or covering a particular theme. Even if the classes are lecture-based, students are encouraged to be interactive, and use their analytical skills to exchange on the subject matter.
