Course description

19th and 20th-century British Literature: the Victorian Era (1837-1901) into Thatcherism This literature tutorial addresses questions of society, politics and class through the reading of three works, explored in relation to the lecture course (CM), covering key moments in the nineteenth and twentieth centuries. Other themes to be brought up include social evolution, management and engineering, civilisation and barbarism, and memory of war. Students improve their skills in textual analysis, essay writing and structure, and oral presentation.
