CONFERENCES Multiple free conferences are organized on campus, by both French and international scholars and experts.





















ACADEMIC INFORMATION

Placement Test

A placement test is mandatory.

First your French level is partially determined by an online test taken before your arrival in France (your login and password will be sent to you by e-mail).

Your final level is then determined upon arrival at ILCF in Paris. You will receive an appointment for your placement test, which will take place:

- for semester sessions, the week before classes begin
- for monthly sessions, on the first day of class.

Schedule

For semester sessions, a professor will advise and help you to build your schedule, according to your level, objectives, interests and the amount of hours chosen. For monthly sessions, the schedule is pre-set.

Exams

For French language courses, the exams are based on continuous assessment and a final exam at the end of the session based on the four competences: oral and written expression and oral and written comprehension.

Certificate

At the end of each session, you will receive a "Certificate of Study of French as a Foreign Language" mentioning the courses and the number of hours taken, the level acquired or currently in progress and the ECTS credits obtained.

European Credit Transfer System (ECTS)

The ECTS are attributed if your average in the course is equal or higher than 10 out of 20.

10 hours of courses are equivalent to 1 credit ECTS.

Authorized Examination Center

ILCF is a partner of the Paris Ile-de-France Chamber of Commerce and Industry, and is an authorized examination center to prepare and take the DFP (Diploma in Professional French) and the TEF (French Evaluation Test).

PRACTICAL INFORMATION

Before registering

For stays of more than three months, if you need a student visa, or if you are a beginner, you must register for either 15, 18 or 21 hours per week.

For any question related to visas, please consult the Campus France office, the French Consulate or the French Embassy in your country.

We advise you to register as early as possible, in order to take into account the time it takes to obtain a visa [between one and three months]
