Overview

Taught entirely in English, it combines international relations, political science, economics, and management. Students acquire both solid theoretical knowledge and practical skills to analyze, design, and evaluate international strategies in economic, diplomatic, and social contexts.

In an increasingly globalized and interconnected world, this program prepares students to understand international challenges and make informed decisions in real-life situations, such as managing international projects, analyzing economic risks, or resolving crises.

Master 1 – Foundations and Methods

M1 introduces the fundamentals of international relations, global economic and political governance, and contemporary international issues. Students also develop methodological and practical skills essential for analyzing complex situations and understanding the mechanisms of international cooperation and decision-making.

Master 2 – International Analysis and Strategy

M2 deepens themes such as international security, economic and trade policy, and crisis and global risk management. It emphasizes strategic analysis, international decision-making, and preparation for professional practice, enabling students to design and evaluate strategies in international and multicultural contexts.
